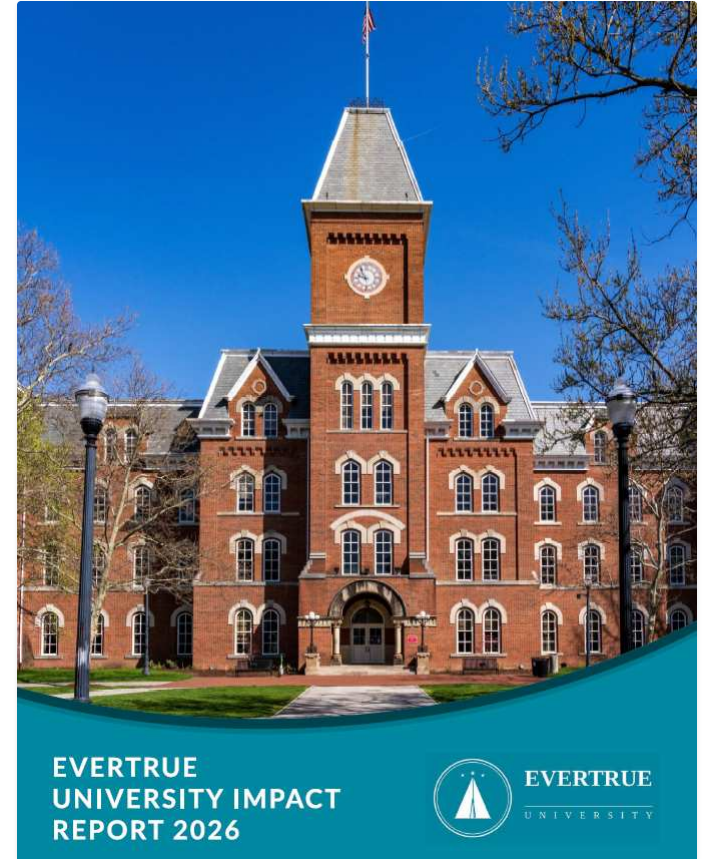

ENDOWMENT OVERVIEW

EverTrue University's endowment is a dedicated and permanent source of funding that sustains the teaching and research mission of the University. Made up of hundreds of individual funds invested together as a single pool, the endowment's returns support financial aid, innovative research, and endowed professorships across the University's schools and colleges.

Each year, a measured portion of the endowment is paid out as an annual distribution to support the University's budget. Any appreciation beyond that distribution is reinvested and retained, so the endowment can continue to grow and support future generations. In this way, the endowment provides a financial foundation the University can rely on for decades to come. In fiscal year 2026, it distributed \$10.2 million toward research, scholarships, and program support.

Distributions from the endowment are a critical source of funding for the University. The overwhelming majority of these funds are restricted gifts that must be spent in accordance with the terms set forth by the donor who created them. Payout from a restricted fund can only be used in support of that fund's designated purpose — which means your gift does precisely what you intended it to do, this year and every year that follows.

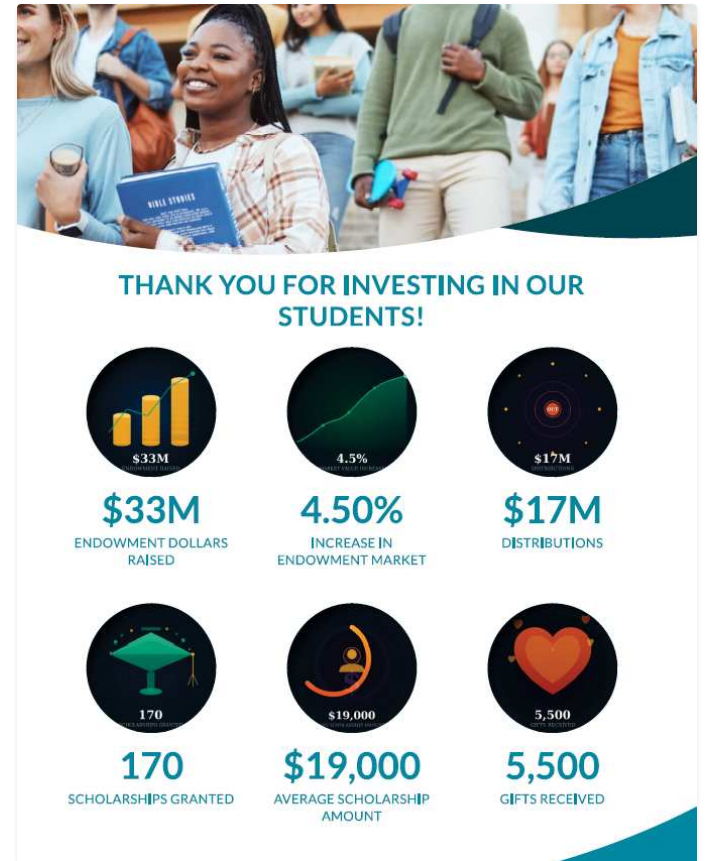

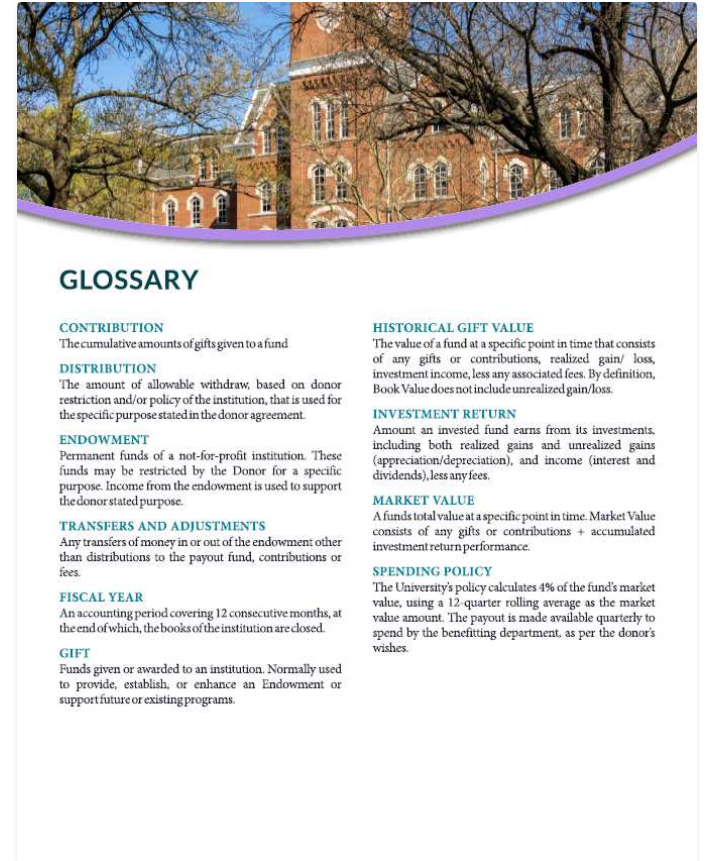
